<u>O R D E R</u>

On April 13, 1995, the Commission issued its Final Order in this case authorizing Intercom, Inc. ("Intercom") to resell intrastate, long-distance telecommunications services in Kentucky. Intercom has now notified the Commission that it has not commenced business and that its sole incorporator and both members of its Board of Directors have determined that the corporation should be dissolved.

The Commission finds that, since Intercom has never supplied service to Kentucky customers, the interests of the public will in no way be adversely affected by the withdrawal of Intercom from the ranks of telecommunications providers in Kentucky. Consequently, Intercom's tariff to provide service in Kentucky should be canceled, and Intercom should be removed from the Commission's list of active utilities.

The Commission being sufficiently advised, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The tariff of Intercom, Inc. to provide service in Kentucky is hereby canceled.

2. Intercom, Inc. is hereby removed from the Commission's list of active utilities.
