<u>O R D E R</u>

On July 20, 1995, Long Distance Services, Inc. ("LDSI") was granted authority to resell telecommunications services in Kentucky. On January 23, 1996, LDSI filed a petition to assign its authority to Phone Calls Inc. ("PCI"). In its petition, LDSI maintains that there are several other companies across the nation conducting business under a similar name. Daniel Fletcher is the sole officer, director and shareholder of LDSI and PCI. In order to avoid confusion, he is changing the name of his company from LDSI to PCI. LDSI's tariff is unchanged except for the addition of the new name.

Being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. LDSI's name shall be changed to PCI.

2. PCI's proposed tariff is hereby approved.
