APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION IN CASE NO. 96-153 DATED SEPTEMBER 30, 1996

Topics to be discussed:

1. Alternatives and their costs considered instead of converting line sections 457, 456, 455, 453, 451, 447 and 614 of Helechawa Substation from 1/0 ACSR to three-phase 336.4.

2. Alternatives and their costs considered instead of converting line sections 558, 542 and 541 of Sublett Substation from 3/0 ACSR to three-phase 336.4 MCM ACSR.

The above information was requested by the Commission Order dated August 15, 1996. However, Licking Valley Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation did not provide the costs of the alternatives. The responses raised some questions that can be better discussed and addressed at the informal conference.
