
O R D E R

On April 19, 1996, Health Liability Management Corporation ("HLMC") tendered for filing an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for authority to resell telecommunications services in Kentucky. The application failed to comply with Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(3), and HLMC was notified of this deficiency by letter dated April 30, 1996 from the Executive Director's office. The deficiency was not cured and a reminder letter was sent on June 19, 1996. Due to HLMC's failure to cure the noted deficiency, the Commission finds that this docket should be closed without prejudice to HLMC's right to refile an application that satisfies the regulatory filing requirements.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this docket is closed.
