## ORDER

On May 2, 1996, Kentucky CGSA, Inc. ("Kentucky CGSA") filed an application with the Commission requesting a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate a cellular facility at 5612 Old Heady Road, Louisville, Jefferson County, Kentucky. A neighbor requested intervention. The request was granted by Order dated May 24, 1996. Subsequently, another neighbor wrote to the Commission to state he opposes the location of the tower. To date, no request for hearing has been submitted.

The Commission, on its own motion, therefore schedules a hearing on the proposed cellular facility is scheduled for September 4, 1996, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 730 Schenkel Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky. If a party wishes to appear at the hearing in opposition to the proposed facility he must, within 10 days of the date of this Order, so notify the Commission. If no statement of intent to appear at the hearing and to present evidence

against the proposed facility are received by the Commission, the hearing shall be cancelled and this matter submitted to the Commission for a decision based on the record.

The Commission being sufficiently advised, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. A hearing on the proposed cell site is scheduled for September 4, 1996, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 730 Schenkel Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky.
- 2. Kentucky CGSA shall appear at the hearing and be prepared to present testimony on the engineering design, location, and construction of the proposed cell site, as well as the safety issues relating to the cell site.
- 3. Any interested person shall have the opportunity to present testimony or comment on any aspect of the proposed cell site.
- 4. Pursuant to KRS 100.324, a copy of this Order is being sent to the Louisville and Jefferson County Planning Commission for the purpose of notification that the above-scheduled hearing may affect locations or relocations of service facilities within the planning unit's jurisdiction.
- 5. A party who wishes to appear at the hearing in opposition to the proposed cell cite shall file a statement to that effect within 10 days of the date of this Order.
- 6. If the Commission does not receive, within 10 days of the date of this Order, a statement expressing a party's intent to appear in opposition to the proposed cell site, the hearing shall be cancelled and the matter shall be submitted to the Commission for a decision on the record.
