O R D E R

On May 30, 1996, Campbell County Kentucky Water District ("Campbell County") filed its application with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") for the purpose of adjusting its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure. KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068.

The Commission, having reviewed the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. Campbell County purchases water from two suppliers, City of Newport ("Newport") and Kenton County Water District ("Kenton County").
2. Effective May 20, 1996, Newport increased its rates for wholesale water from \$.69 per 1,000 gallons to \$.795 per 1,000 gallons.
3. Campbell County proposed to increase the rates to its customers effective May 20, 1996.
4. During the 12 months ending April 30, 1996, Campbell County purchased 1,677,066,100 gallons of water from Newport and 541,290,000 gallons of water from Kenton County. During that same period of time, Campbell County sold 1,901,017,500 gallons of water.

5. Campbell County's purchased water adjustment calculations show an increase in purchased water cost of \$176,091, resulting in a purchased water adjustment of .09 cent per 1,000 gallons. Based on an average quarterly usage of 15,000 gallons, quarterly bills to Campbell County customers will increase from \$54.05 to \$55.45, an increase of 2.6 percent.

6. The purchased water adjustment of .09 cent per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

7. Campbell County's proposed tariff is correct and should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE
COMMISSION IN CASE NO. 96-251 DATED JUNE 24, 1996

The following rates and charges are prescribed for the customers in the area served by Campbell County Kentucky Water District. All other rates and charges not specifically mentioned herein shall remain the same as those in effect under authority of this Commission prior to the effective date of this Order.

RATES:

Minimum Quarterly charges by meter size shall apply only when consumption falls below the required amounts for each size meter.
