O R D E R

This matter arising upon the motions of Cynthia P. McDonald and Tim Gelhausen for full intervention, and it appearing to the Commission that Ms. McDonald and Mr. Gelhausen have a special interest which is not otherwise adequately represented, and that such intervention is likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings, Ms. McDonald's and Mr. Gelhausen's motions to intervene should be granted. Ms. McDonald also requests that a hearing should be set in this matter. However, a number of interested persons have contacted the Commission in regard to this cell site and may yet wish to file motions to intervene. Consequently, the Commission will hold in abeyance Ms. McDonald's motion for a hearing and will address it at the appropriate time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The motions of Cynthia P. McDonald and Tim Gelhausen to intervene are granted.

2. Ms. McDonald and Mr. Gelhausen shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.

3. Should Ms. McDonald or Mr. Gelhausen file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of these proceedings, they shall also serve a copy of said documents on all other parties of record.

4. Ms. McDonald's motion for a hearing shall be held in abeyance until further Order of the Commission.
