
O R D E R

On July 12, 1996, six wholly-owned subsidiaries of Nextel Communications, Inc. ("Nextel") filed requests for authority to operate Commercial Mobile Radio Services/Specialized Mobile Radio Services in Kentucky. Nextel has determined that PowerFone, Inc. will now be the only subsidiary to operate in Kentucky. It is a sister subsidiary of Dial Call Kentucky, Inc., and will construct the wide area specialized mobile radio system under the licenses assigned to all of Nextel's wholly-owned subsidiaries in Kentucky. Having one operating subsidiary in Kentucky rather than six will reduce the confusion and eliminate multiple filings with the Commission. Accordingly, Dial Call Kentucky, Inc.'s motion for withdrawal of its application should be granted.


