ORDER

On July 12, 1996, six wholly-owned subsidiaries of Nextel Communications, Inc. ("Nextel") filed requests for authority to operate Commercial Mobile Radio Services/Specialized Mobile Radio Services in Kentucky. Nextel has determined that PowerFone, Inc. will now be the only subsidiary to operate in Kentucky. It is a sister subsidiary of OneComm Corporation, N.A., and will construct the wide area specialized mobile radio system under the licenses assigned to all of Nextel's wholly-owned subsidiaries in Kentucky. Having one operating subsidiary in Kentucky rather than six will reduce the confusion and eliminate multiple filings with the Commission. Accordingly, OneComm Corporation, N.A.'s motion for withdrawal of its application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that OneComm Corporation, N.A.'s application for authority to do business in Kentucky is hereby withdrawn and dismissed.
