O R D E R


On September 9, 1996, The Union Light, Heat and Power Company ("UGH&P") filed a letter, which the Commission will treat as a motion, advising the Commission that GTE Mobilnet Incorporated has satisfactorily resolved its concerns regarding the proposed personal communications service facility to be constructed at 1261 Mineola Pike, Erlanger, Boone County, Kentucky, and further advising that it wished to withdraw as an intervenor in this proceeding.

After considering the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that ULH&P's motion is granted and it is removed as a party to this proceeding.
