ORDER

Pursuant to Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:056, Section 1(11), the Commission on December 27, 1993, established this proceeding to review and evaluate the operation of the fuel adjustment clause ("FAC") of Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU) for the 6 months ended October 31, 1993.

After holding a hearing, the Commission ordered that this docket remain open until a full and complete review of the evidence and argument presented in a Federal Energy Regulatory Commission proceeding¹ on KU's depreciation practices for certain railcars and its accounting of the proceeds from the lease and subsequent sale of these railcars. On January 2, 1997, the Commission issued an Order in Case No. 92-493² addressing these issues.
