## <u>ORDER</u>

On February 10, 1997, Timothy and Rose Swan ("Petitioners") filed with the Commission a letter, which the Commission will treat as a motion, requesting full intervention and a hearing in this matter. Petitioners state no grounds for their request.

807 KAR 5:001, Section 3(8), requires a person requesting intervention to "specify his interest in the proceeding." The regulation further states that the Commission shall grant a request for intervention if it determines that the requester has a "special interest in the proceeding which is not otherwise adequately represented" or that he is "likely to present issues or to develop facts that assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings."

Petitioners have not specified their interest. Nor have they stated any issues or facts which have bearing on this matter and which they are uniquely qualified to present. Consequently, the Commission cannot make the findings of fact necessary to grant their motion. However, a hearing is scheduled in this matter for February 20, 1997 at 10:00 a.m.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Petitioners' request for full intervention is denied.
