O R D E R

This matter arising upon the motions of the Kentucky Rural Water Association, Inc. ("KRWA") and the Kentucky League of Cities ("League of Cities") for full intervention, and it appearing to the Commission that the KRWA and the League of Cities have a special interest which is not otherwise adequately represented, and that such intervention is likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings, and this Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The motions of the KRWA and the League of Cities to intervene are granted.
2. The KRWA and the League of Cities shall each be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.
3. Should either the KRWA or the League of Cities file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of these proceedings, they shall also serve a copy of said documents on all other parties of record.
