## <u>O R D E R</u>

On February 18, 1997, Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E"); the Attorney General; Jefferson County, Kentucky; Metro Human Needs Alliance; People Organized and Working for Energy Reform; Louisville Resource Conservation Council; Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers; and Louisville Jefferson County Community Action Agencies, (collectively, the "Collaborative") tendered for filing a joint application requesting Commission approval of: (1) changes to the demand-side management ("DSM") Cost Recovery Mechanism; (2) a new residential audit program and its budget; and (3) cost recovery by LG&E for 1997 and 1998 based upon the revised and new budgets submitted with the application. The Collaborative also filed a formal report which reviewed the effectiveness and achievements of the operation of the Collaborative, as required by the Principles of Agreement approved in Case No. 93-150.1

Case No. 93-150, A Joint Application for the Approval of Demand-Side Management Programs, a DSM Cost Recovery Mechanism, and a Continuing Collaborative Process on DSM for Louisville Gas and Electric Company, Order dated November 12, 1993.

Collaborative also requested that a procedural schedule be set for the consideration of

the joint application.

In its June 24, 1996 Order in Case No. 93-150, the Commission determined that

it would employ an independent DSM consultant with expertise in fiscal and policy

management and administration to review the Collaborative's operation and processes

as part of the three-year review. The Commission expects to receive a report from

Corporate Economic Strategies, Inc. ("CES") by May 1997 and will allow the

Collaborative an opportunity to engage in discovery concerning this report.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The procedural schedule set forth in Appendix A, attached hereto and

incorporated herein, shall be followed in this proceeding. Additional dates will be

established in subsequent Orders.

2. All requests for information and responses thereto shall be appropriately

indexed. All responses shall include the name of the witness who will be responsible for

responding to questions related to the information, with copies to all parties of record and

an original and 10 copies to the Commission.
