ORDER

On July 25, 1997, Green River Electric Corporation ("Green River") applied to the Commission for authority to adjust its rates. In its filing, Green River requested permission to deviate from certain requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10, which relate to the filing of financial exhibits.

Specifically, Green River has requested a waiver of the following requirements: Section 10(6)(h), which requires the submission of a summary of the determination of revenue requirements; Section 10(6)(i), which requires a reconciliation of rate base and capital used to determine revenue requirements; Section 10(6)(j), which requires a current chart of accounts; Section 10(6)(k), which requires an independent auditor's annual opinion report; Section 10(6)(r), which requires monthly managerial reports providing financial results for the 12 months in the test period; Section 10(6)(t), which requires affiliate payments; and Section 10(6)(u), which requires a cost-of-service study.

Having reviewed the filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the information filed therein is sufficient to enable the Commission to review adequately Green River's filing. Therefore, its request for permission to deviate from the above-cited regulation should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Green River's request for permission to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10, is hereby granted.
