("Jefferson") shall each file separately the original and 6 copies of the following information with the Commission with a copy to all parties of record no later than August 22, 1997. Public and Jefferson shall furnish with each response the name of the witness who will be available to respond to questions concerning each item of information should a public hearing be scheduled.

- 1. What is the capacity of the odorizer tank?
- 2. Provide the monthly usage of the odorant and the amount of odorant added in pounds per million cubic foot of gas.
 - 3. How old is the odorization system?
 - 4. Provide a copy of the weekly record of odorant level for 1996.
- 5. Provide the chemical composition and the brand name of the odorant used as given by the supplier.
 - 6. Provide the name, address and telephone number of the odorant supplier.

7. Provide a copy of the operating and maintenance manual for the odorization

unit.

8. With reference to the inspection report, the odorant level at the residence of

Berry Combs is higher than the acceptable level pursuant to 807 KAR 5:022, Section

13(17)(a). Explain how and when will Jefferson remedy this deficiency to the

Commission's regulations.

9. How many gas wells provide gas to Public and Jefferson? Provide the

highest and lowest detectable odorant level in the gas produced from these wells.

10. Provide a brief description of Public's and Jefferson's systems. Include gas

production, number of customers, gas sales, transportation and operation.
