## <u>O R D E R</u>

On June 20, 1997, the Muhlenberg County Water District No. 3 ("Muhlenberg No. 3") applied for permission to deviate from Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 4(4), which requires that each utility maintain minimum water storage of one day's supply of its average daily usage. Muhlenberg No. 3 states in its application that its average daily water usage, including unaccounted-for water, is approximately 533,546 gallons, and that its current water storage capacity is 500,000 gallons.

The Commission, having reviewed the application and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. Muhlenberg No. 3 is not in compliance with Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 4(4).

2. Because of the time needed to plan, finance, and implement a program to construct water storage facilities, Muhlenberg No. 3 should be given until July 1, 2003 to comply with 807 KAR 5:066, Section 4(4).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Muhlenberg No. 3 is given until July 1, 2003 to comply with the provisions of 807 KAR 5:066, Section 4(4).

Muhlenberg No. 3 shall take all necessary actions to bring its water storage 2. facilities into compliance with Commission regulations prior to July 1, 2003.
