ORDER

GTE South Incorporated ("GTE"), BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and BellSouth Cellular Corporation have petitioned the Commission to rehear or clarify several issues. AT&T Communications of the South Central States, Inc. has responded to GTE's petition.

The Commission will grant rehearing of all issues raised in the petitions, except those regarding the selection of the HAI Model which is currently the subject of Federal Communications Commission review.¹ The Commission will, however, in its Order on the petitions submitted, provide additional clarification of its model selection. Any party wishing to respond to the petitions may do so by no later than July 13, 1998. The Commission will enter an Order regarding these petitions on or before August 7, 1998.

Having considered the petitions for rehearing, and having been otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. Rehearing regarding the selection of the HAI Model is denied.
