## ORDER

On November 24, 1998, the Commission directed Murray Water District No. 1 ("Murray District") and the members of its Board of Commissioners to show cause why they should not be penalized for their failure to provide direct water service to the residents of Wildcat Village Subdivision as required by the Commission's Order of May 22, 1998. Murray District and its Commissioners have submitted written responses to the Order to Show Cause and have requested that the Commission close this proceeding without further action.

Having considered the response and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that, as of December 2, 1998, Murray District has complied with the Order of May 22, 1998 and is providing direct water service to the residents of Wildcat Village Subdivision and that further proceedings in this matter are no longer required.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The Commission's Order of November 24, 1998 is vacated.
- 2. This proceeding is closed and shall be removed from the Commission's docket.
