<u>ORDER</u>

On September 23, 1998, Kentucky CGSA, Inc. ("Kentucky CGSA") filed a Motion to Reopen Case and Modify Order ("Motion"). Kentucky CGSA asked that the Order issued in this case on November 26, 1997, granting a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct and operate a monopole antenna tower not to exceed 130 feet in height with attached antennas, be modified to permit Kentucky CGSA to increase the height of the tower to 133 feet. Kentucky CGSA also wishes to install a lightning rod on the tower. Kentucky CGSA has filed with its Motion an engineering drawing depicting the proposed modification, and explains that the modification is necessary in order to permit co-location of the antennas of WirelessCo., L.P., on the structure.

The Commission finds that Kentucky CGSA's motion is reasonable and that the proposed co-location furthers the Commission's policy of encouraging co-location of wireless telecommunications antennas whenever possible.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Motion of Kentucky CGSA to Reopen Case and Modify Order is granted and that the authority granted by the final Order in this case is hereby modified as described herein.
