O R D E R


On May 14, 1998, Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company ("CBT") petitioned the Commission to rehear the April 24, 1998 Order establishing a wholesale discount rate for competitive local exchange carriers. CBT argues that the discount of 15.37 percent is contrary to law and incorrectly calculated. The Commission will grant rehearing to consider CBT's assertions.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. CBT's petition for rehearing shall be granted to enable the Commission to further consider CBT's arguments.


