Bradley, Sr., Johnny Mynbrier Bradley, JoAnn C. Needham, Donnie Martin, and Carolyn Martin for approval to petition Menifee County Fiscal Court for the creation of a water district in Menifee County, Kentucky is dismissed with prejudice.
