ORDER

On December 17, 1997, Elk Lake Water Company ("Elk Lake") and Tri-Village Water District ("Tri-Village") filed a joint petition for the transfer of 25 customers from Elk Lake to Tri-Village. The filing contains, as an exhibit, a copy of an agreement between the parties requesting the transfer. The petition requests a deviation under 807 KAR 5:001, Section 14, from any regulation that would tend to delay or limit the application. Upon review of the petition, the Commission finds that the record must be supplemented by each party.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Elk Lake shall file with the Commission within 10 days from the date of this Order the following:
- a. Schedule A of the agreement dated December 11, 1997, and the date the letters were mailed to customers.
 - b. Any written response to letters by any customer.
- c. Statement that loss of 25 customers will not adversely affect Elk Lake's financial or operational ability to serve remaining customers.

- 2. Tri-Village shall file with the Commission within 10 days from the date of this Order the following:
- a. A map of the area affected showing the lines of each party (a copy of a general highway map with area outlined will suffice).
- b. A statement that the proposed transfer as agreed will not require a bond issue or surcharge on rates at present to serve the new 25 customers.
