On May 18, 1998, SprintCom, Inc. ("SprintCom") filed by fax a motion to continue the public hearing scheduled for May 19, 1998. SprintCom stated to the Commission that one of its primary witnesses was ill and unable to testify. An intervenor, Arlinghaus Builders, Inc.("Arlinghaus Builders"), filed by fax a response to the motion in which it opposed the continuance and requested limitations on the witness testimony, if the continuance was granted. Arlinghaus Builders alleges in its response that the information supplied to it and filed with the Commission on April 20, 1998 is incomplete. The Commission notes that both intervenors in this case object to the continuance.

The Commission, having reviewed the file, the motion for continuance, and the response thereto, and otherwise being sufficiently advised;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The motion for a continuance of the public hearing in this case is granted.

2. The intervenor, Arlinghaus Builders, may file within five days any request for any information it believes was not furnished by the Applicant in the response served April 16, 1998, and filed with the Commission on April 20, 1998. SprintCom shall respond to Arlinghaus Builders request, if any, by May 30, 1998.
