O R D E R


On February 3, 1998, Horizon Personal Communications, Inc. ("Horizon") filed an application seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to build and operate a cellular radio telecommunications facility for the Basic Trading Area No. B197. By letter dated March 26, 1998, Horizon informed the Commission of its desire to install a wooden utility pole at this site. The Commission informed Horizon that this would be considered construction in the ordinary course of business that would not require a CPCN. On May 28, 1998, Horizon moved to withdraw its application in this case.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Case No. 98-074 is withdrawn and closed.


