ORDER

On November 16, 1998, Kenneth and Mary Elizabeth Blair ("Complainants") filed with this Commission their Petition for Rehearing in the above case.

The Commission, having considered the Petition for Rehearing, all evidence of record, and being fully advised, finds that:

- 1. Complainants, in their Petition for Rehearing, have not introduced any pertinent information into the record that was not considered by the Commission in the preparation of its Order dated October 23, 1998.
- 2. Complainants state in their Petition for Rehearing that unauthorized use of their telephone credit card was not an issue before the Commission and that the issue is presently being pursued by Complainants in the Fayette Circuit Court. The Commission specifically recognized at Page 3 of its Order dated October 23, 1998 that unauthorized calls were not an issue before the Public Service Commission and no

decision was made by the Commission regarding unauthorized use of Complainants' telephone credit card.

- 3. The findings and orders set forth in the Commission's Order dated October 23, 1998 should be reaffirmed.
 - 4. The Complainants' Petition for Rehearing should be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Petition for Rehearing filed by the Complainants on November 16, 1998 is denied.
