ORDER

Crown Communication, Inc. and Nextel West Corp. ("Applicants") have moved to withdraw their application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct a telecommunications services facility to be located at 571 McKinley Street, Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky. In support of their motion, Applicants stated that forecasted interest in collocation had not been achieved and that infrastructure demand was insufficient to justify the proposed site at this time. Based on the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that good cause exists to allow the application to be withdrawn.
