O R D E R

Delta Natural Gas Company, Inc. ("Delta") filed a motion with the Commission on August 27, 1998, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7, for confidential protection of portions of a special contract with a selected customer on the grounds that disclosure is likely to cause Delta competitive injury. Delta also requested consolidation and a formal hearing with two other cases pending before the Commission. This application has been assigned Case No. 98-479.

The Commission has reviewed the filings contained in Case No. 98-380 and Case No. 98-412 and finds the issues regarding confidential treatment of certain contract information is substantially similar in both cases and they should be consolidated with Case No. 98-479 for administrative purposes.


Delta has requested that it be granted a formal hearing in this case. The Commission finds that Delta should be granted a formal hearing in Case No. 98-479.

The Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Case No. 98-479, Case No. 98-380, and Case No. 98-412 are to be consolidated for all administrative and hearing purposes.
2. Delta's motion for a formal hearing is granted in Case No. 98-479 and is consolidated with Case No. 98-380 and Case No. 98-412 for a formal hearing on September 17, 1998 at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 730 Schenkel Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky.
3. Pending a hearing and final decision in Case No. 98-479, the contract information for which Delta seeks confidential protection shall be held and retained by the Commission as confidential and shall not be open for public inspection.
