ORDER

On September 2, 1998, the Commission ordered Digital Network Services, Inc. ("DNS") to show cause why it should not be penalized for having failed to comply with KRS Chapter 278 and the Commission regulations duly authorized thereunder for failure to file its Gross Revenue Report. The Commission finds that on May 6, 1997 the Commission rejected the tariff submitted by DNS and that no subsequent tariff has been filed. DNS was therefore not required to file a Gross Revenue Report for 1997 and this action should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case is dismissed and the hearing scheduled for October 7, 1998 at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, is canceled.
