<u>ORDER</u>

On October 22, 1998, Kentucky Turnpike Water District ("Kentucky Turnpike") filed a contract with the Commission wherein it proposed to supply water to the city of Lebanon Junction.

The Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed contract. The district did not specify a date upon which the contract will be effective; thus, suspension of the contract pursuant to KRS 278.190 is not required.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the proposed contract filing of Kentucky Turnpike shall not become effective prior to the conclusion of this proceeding.
