ORDER

On December 18, 1991, in Case No. 91-138, the Commission approved certain adjusted rates for Kentucky-Ohio Gas Company (KOG) and provided for their further adjustment in accordance with its gas cost adjustment (GCA) clause.

On October 1, 1999, KOG filed its gas cost adjustment (GCA) to be effective as of the filing date of October 1, 1999.

The Commission finds that:

- KOG s filing did not provide the required 30-day notice for an adjustment of rates. The earliest date new rates could be effective is November 1, 1999.
- 2. Pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the cost of gas KOG has charged its customers since its last GCA application and such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the November 1, 1999 effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- The proposed rates are hereby suspended for 5 months from November 1,
 1999 up to and including March 31, 2000.
- 2. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
