ORDER

On March 26, 1998, the Commission approved a resale agreement between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) and Push Button Paging & Communications (Push Button). On March 19, 1999 and May 10, 1999, BellSouth and Push Button submitted to the Commission amendments to their resale agreement. The agreement was negotiated pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (1996 Act), 47 U.S.C. Sections 251 and 252. Section 252(e) of the 1996 Act requires the parties to an interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation to submit the agreement for approval to the Commission.

The Commission has reviewed the amendments and finds that no portion of the amendments discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement. The Commission also finds that the implementation of these amendments is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

The Commission, having been otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS	
that the amendments are approved.
