O R D E R

On July 17, 1998, the Commission approved a resale agreement between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) and U.S. Dial Tone, Inc. (Dial Tone). On October 16, 1998, the Commission approved an amendment to the aforesaid resale agreement. On November 9, 1998, BellSouth and Dial Tone submitted to the Commission an amendment to their resale agreement (which concerned a facility in a denied state) and on November 16, 1998, BellSouth and Dial Tone submitted to the Commission an amendment to their resale agreement (which concerned Operational Support Systems). The agreement was negotiated pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (1996 Act), 47 U.S.C. Sections 251 and 252. Section 252(e) of the 1996 Act requires the parties to an interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation to submit the agreement for approval to the Commission.

The Commission has reviewed the amendments and finds that no portion of the amendments discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement. The Commission also finds that the implementation of these amendments is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

The Commission, having been otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that the amendments are approved.
