O R D E R

On February 18, 1999, Crown Communication Inc. and Nextel West Corp. (Applicants) filed a motion to amend the application. The purpose of the amendment is to reflect a new location for the proposed wireless communications facility. The new site is approximately 300 feet from the previous location on adjacent real estate owned by the same lessor. The proposed site, as revised, is to be located at 5451 Paris Pike (180 Harp-Innis Road), Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky. The coordinates are North Latitude 38° 8 30.72 by West Longitude 84° 22 13.8 . The Commission finds that the motion to amend the application should be granted. The Applicants have provided evidence of written notification to the local planning unit and one additional property which was not within 500 feet of the original location.

The Commission, being sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that the February 18, 1999 motion to amend the application is granted.
