ORDER

On September 2, 1998, the Public Service Commission (Commission) ordered Telcom Network, Inc. (Telcom) to show cause why it should not be penalized for having failed to comply with KRS 278.230(3). A hearing in this matter was held before the Honorable Paul Shapiro at the offices of the Commission on October 7, 1998. Neither Telcom nor its attorney appeared at the hearing. By letter received October 19, 1998, Telcom informed this Commission that although it sought, and was granted, authorization to provide telecommunications service in the Commonwealth of Kentucky in 1995, it never provided telecommunications service in this state, and ceased operating as a corporation in 1996. Telcom requested that this action be dismissed and its tariff cancelled.

Having reviewed the evidence and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that this action should be dismissed and the tariff of Telcom cancelled.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
