O R D E R

Kentucky Turnpike Water District (Kentucky Turnpike) has moved to withdraw the filing of its contract with the city of Lebanon Junction (Lebanon Junction). Kentucky Turnpike states that it cancelled the subject contract at Lebanon Junction s request and that the parties are negotiating a new contract in which Kentucky Turnpike would act as an emergency back-up supply to Lebanon Junction.

After being sufficiently advised, the Commission finds good cause exists to dismiss this application. When the new contract is available for the Commission s review, Kentucky Turnpike may submit it for Commission approval. The Commission further finds that Kentucky Turnpike should be relieved from its obligations under the Commission s Order of April 30, 1999.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Kentucky Turnpike s motion is granted.
2. Kentucky Turnpike is granted leave to withdraw its contract with Lebanon Junction.

3. Kentucky Turnpike is relieved of its obligations under the Commission's April 30, 1999 Order.

4. This matter is dismissed without prejudice and shall be removed from the Commission's docket.
