O R D E R

This matter arising upon the motion of David E. Scheurich¹ for full intervention, and it appearing to the Commission that Mr. Scheurich has a special interest which is not otherwise adequately represented, and that such intervention is likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings, and this Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The motion of David E. Scheurich to intervene is granted.
2. Mr. Scheurich shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings,

¹ Mr. Scheurich is being granted intervention individually. Mr. Scheurich's letter states that he is intervening in his capacity as plant manager for Labrot & Graham Distillers, Inc. However, if Labrot & Graham wishes to intervene, it must be represented by a licensed attorney.
