## <u>O R D E R</u>

Nolin Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (Nolin) has applied to the Commission for authority to incur additional indebtedness in the approximate amounts of \$13 million and \$4.3 million, respectively.

KRS 278.300(2) provides that the Commission shall have 60 days after filing to consider applications for authority to issue or assume securities or evidences of indebtedness unless it is necessary for good cause to continue the application. As the Commission has not completed its investigation of these matters, the Commission finds that good cause exists to continue the financing applications beyond the 60-day period

specified in KRS 278.300(2).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Nolin's applications for authority to incur additional indebtedness are continued beyond the 60-day period specified in KRS 278.300(2).
