ORDER

On August 9, 1999, the Commission granted rehearing of its July 1, 1999 Order. The purpose of this rehearing proceeding is to establish a maximum per-minute toll rate for interLATA and intraLATA calls originating from confinement facilities. Moreover, alternatives to the establishment of a maximum per-minute toll rate are being considered.

Testimony regarding these matters has been filed by MCI WorldCom, Inc. and Evercom Systems, Inc. In addition, several parties have responded to the data requests of The Plaintiffs' Group.
