ORDER

In its Order of June 6, 1994, the Commission authorized Lakewood Valley Sewer Company, Inc. ("Lakewood") "to assess a monthly surcharge of \$1.35 per customer for a period not to exceed 5 years, or until \$18,000 has been collected." On February 16, 2000, Lakewood advised the Commission in writing that as a result of a billing error by its billing agent, the Oldham County Water District, it had collected \$19,880.80 from the surcharge, \$1,880.80 more than authorized. Lakewood requested Commission approval to refund the excess surcharge proceeds to its existing customers on a pro-rata basis through a billing credit. The Commission shall consider Lakewood's request as a motion.


Having considered the motion and finding good cause exists to grant the motion, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. Lakewood's motion is granted.
2. Within 30 days of refunding the excess collections through a billing credit, Lakewood shall file with the Commission a list of customers to whom excess collections were refunded and the amount refunded.
