<u>ORDER</u>

On November 1, 1994, in Case No. 94-179, the Commission approved certain adjusted rates for Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. ("Columbia") and provided for their further adjustment on a quarterly basis in accordance with Columbia's gas cost adjustment ("GCA") clause.

On May 2, 2000, Columbia filed its GCA to be effective June 1, 2000 to August 31, 2000.

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

- 1. Columbia's notice proposed revised rates designed to pass on its expected increased wholesale gas costs to its customers. Columbia's proposed expected gas cost ("EGC") for the quarter beginning June 1, 2000 is \$4.6487 per Mcf, an increase of 35.21 cents per Mcf from Columbia's last EGC.
- Columbia's notice set out a rate for Banking and Balancing Service of
 2.06 cents per Mcf.
 - 3. Columbia's notice set out no take-or-pay refund adjustment.

- 4. Columbia's notice set out no transportation take-or-pay refund adjustment.
- 5. Columbia's notice set out a current quarter refund adjustment ("RA") in the amount of .5 cent per Mcf to return refunds of \$82,505, including interest, to Columbia's customers. The total RA of 3.24 cents per Mcf reflects previous quarter adjustments, and represents a decrease of .4 cent per Mcf from the total RA last approved for Columbia.
- 6. Columbia's notice set out its annual actual cost adjustment ("ACA") of 51.80 cents per Mcf to collect under-recovered gas cost from the twelve months ended June 30, 1999.
- 7. Columbia's notice set out its six-month balancing adjustment ("BA") of .93 cent per Mcf to reconcile variances from previous refund and balancing adjustments.
- 8. Columbia's notice set out a Special Agency Service refund adjustment of 0 cents per Mcf. This represents no change from the prior rate.
- 9. The combined effect of the above adjustments is that Columbia's gas cost recovery rate ("GCR") is of \$5.1436 per Mcf, which is 34.81 cents per Mcf more than its previous GCR of \$4.7955 per Mcf.
- 10. The rate adjustments in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable, in the public interest, and should be approved for gas supplied on and after June 1, 2000.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable, and are effective for gas supplied on and after June 1, 2000.

2. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Columbia shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
