<u>ORDER</u>

On November 30, 1999, the Commission entered an Order directing SprintCom, Inc. ("SprintCom") to prefile testimony in response to the issues contained in the Commission's Order dated September 1, 1999 on or before 90 days from November 30, 1999. SprintCom was directed to advise the Commission if it was experiencing problems obtaining the testimony. On February 16, 2000, prior to the expiration of the 90-day period, SprintCom filed a motion for an extension of 30 days within which to comply with the Order. Attached to the motion was the affidavit of Ryan Vaillancourt which indicated that an analysis was being conducted, but that it could not be finished within the time period. Based upon the affidavit, the Commission finds that an extension of time of 30 days from February 17, 2000 should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that SprintCom shall file its testimony as directed by the Commission's Order of November 30, 1999 on or before March 17, 2000.
