## <u>ORDER</u>

On May 26, 2000, Powertel/Kentucky, Inc. ("Powertel") moved for dismissal of its application for authority to construct a wireless telecommunications facility at 106 Daventry Lane, Louisville, Jefferson County, Kentucky. As the basis for its motion to dismiss, Powertel states that it has removed the temporary cell facility at this site and has determined that it can provide adequate coverage with the installation of two collocations on existing structures that are in close proximity to this proposed facility. One antenna will be placed on the AmeriSuites Hotel on Hurstbourne Lane, and the other will be placed on a transmission tower owned by Louisville Gas and Electric Company on Clearcreek Road.

Based on the motion and being sufficiently advised, the Commission finds good cause to allow the application to be withdrawn.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the motion to dismiss is granted and this case shall be removed from the Commission's docket.
