ORDER

On December 21, 1999, in Case No. 99-070, the Commission approved certain adjusted rates for Western Kentucky Gas Company ("Western") and provided for their further adjustment on a quarterly basis in accordance with Western's gas cost adjustment ("GCA") clause.

On June 29, 2000, Western filed its GCA to be effective August 1, 2000 through October 31, 2000.

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. Western's notice proposes revised rates designed to pass to its firm sales customers an expected wholesale increase in gas costs. Western's expected gas cost ("EGC") for firm sales customers is \$5.3713 per Mcf, an increase of \$1.4332 per Mcf from the previous EGC of \$3.9381. The EGC proposed for high load factor ("HLF") firm customers is \$4.8120 per Mcf.

Western also proposes to pass to its interruptible customers a wholesale increase in gas costs. Western's proposed EGC for interruptible sales customers is \$4.8120 per Mcf.

2. Western's proposal set out a current period refund adjustment ("RF") of 1.17 cents per Mcf. The total refund factor of 1.68 cents per Mcf for firm sales customers and HLF customers and 1.68 cents per Mcf for interruptible customers reflect adjustments from previous months.

Western's notice set out no refund adjustment for T-2 firm and T-2 interruptible transportation customers.

- 3. Western's notice set out no change in its correction factor ("CF"). The current CF of 25.02 cents per Mcf will remain in effect until November 1, 2000. The CF is designed to collect net under-collections of gas cost from the seven-month period ending January 31, 2000.
- 4. Western's notice sets out its Performance Based Rate Recovery Factor ("PBRF") of 9.34 cents per Mcf to be effective for the 12-month period beginning February 1, 2000.
- 5. These adjustments produce gas cost adjustments of \$5.6981 per Mcf for firm sales customers, \$5.1388 per Mcf for HLF customers, and \$5.1388 per Mcf for interruptible sales customers. The impact on firm sales customers' bills is an increase of \$1.4215 per Mcf from the previous gas cost adjustment of \$4.2766.
- 6. The rate adjustments in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, reasonable and in the public interest.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved effective for final meter readings on and after August 1, 2000.

2. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Western shall file with the Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized in this Order.

Applicable to: Interruptible Sales Service Rate G-2

Gas Cost Adjustment

To each bill rendered under the above-named rate schedules there shall be added an amount equal to: \$5.1388 per Mcf of gas used during the billing period.
