O R D E R

On September 28, 1999, Sprintcom Inc. ("Sprintcom") filed a motion to remand the hearing scheduled in this case, stating that it had entered into negotiations for co-location. The Commission granted Sprintcom's motion on October 6, 1999 and directed Sprintcom to file a status report on the co-location within thirty days from the date of the Order. No documents were received from Sprintcom until January 14, 2000, when it filed a motion for an extension of time to file the status report to and including March 1, 2000. By Order entered February 16, 2000, the Commission granted Sprintcom's motion; however, the information has not been submitted.

The Commission, having considered the matter and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that this case should be dismissed for Sprintcom's failure to submit the information required.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case is dismissed without prejudice.
