C&J Electric, Inc., Corrigan Electric Co., Inc. and Robards Electric, Inc. ("Complainants") have moved for leave to proceed in this proceeding as limited intervenors. Downey Trenching, Inc. ("Downey Trenching") has moved for an extension of time in which to file testimony in this matter. Defendant has not submitted any response in opposition to these motions. Having considered the motions and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that these motions should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Complainants' Motion for Leave to Continue to Participate as Limited Intervenors is granted.

2. Complainants are granted leave to withdraw from this proceeding as Complainants.

3. Complainants shall be served with the Commission's Orders, but shall not be served with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence and all other documents submitted by the parties. Complainants shall not be certified as parties for the purposes of receiving service of any petition for rehearing or petition for judicial review.

4. Complainants' rights as parties at any hearing in this matter shall be governed by the Commission's Order of August 19, 1999 as amended by our Order of October 22, 1999.

5. The style of this case shall henceforth be "Downey Trenching, Inc. v. Salt River Electric Cooperative Corporation."

6. Downey Trenching's Motion for Extension of Time To File Testimony is granted.

7. Downey Trenching shall, no later than January 18, 2000, file with the Commission in verified form the direct testimony of each witness that it expects to call at the formal hearing.

8. Ordering Paragraph 9c of the Commission's Order of October 22, 1999 is amended to read as follows: "On or before February 15, 2000, each party shall file with the Commission in verified form the testimony of each rebuttal witness that it expects to call at the formal hearing."
