¹ Harry H. Baughman is being granted intervention individually. Mr. Baughman's letter indicated that he wished to intervene on behalf of the Lockwood Homeowners Association. However, if the association wishes to intervene, it must be represented by a licensed attorney. Representation of the rights of others before an administrative agency is considered the practice of law and must be performed by a licensed attorney. Kentucky Bar Association v. Henry Vogt Machine Co., 416 S.W.2d 727 (Ky. 1967).

Should Mr. Baughman file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of these proceedings, he shall also serve a copy of said documents on all other parties of record.
