O R D E R

On December 17, 1999, Gallatin County Water District ("Gallatin County") filed a letter requesting a waiver of the requirement of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6, that the financial exhibits be for a 12-month period, ending not more than 90 days prior to the filing date of the application. The Commission will treat the request as a Motion. Gallatin requests a deviation from this requirement because its 1999 audit has not been completed. It states that it will provide the Commission with the 1999 financial statements upon completion of the audit.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that good cause has been shown by Gallatin County for its request to deviate from the 90-day requirement of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6, and that the motion should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Gallatin County is granted permission to deviate from the 90-day requirement of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6.
