## <u>order</u>

On January 13, 2000, East Clark County Water District ("East Clark") applied to the Commission for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct and finance a waterworks improvement project. In its filing, East Clark requested permission to deviate from the requirements of Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6 and Section 11(2)(c). East Clark states in support of its request that compliance with these requirements will be unduly burdensome from a financial standpoint and will substantially delay construction of the project.

Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6, requires the submission of a detailed financial exhibit for the period ending not more than 90 days prior to the date of the application. Section 11(2)(c) requires the submission of a Uniform System of Accounts account number breakdown of the property to be acquired.

Having reviewed the filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the information filed therein is sufficient to enable the Commission to review adequately East Clark's application and that good cause has been shown to grant the requested deviation from the 90-day requirement of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6. The Commission finds that deviation from Section 11(2)(c) is not required since property will not be acquired for the proposed construction.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. East Clark's request to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6, is granted.

2. East Clark's request to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 11(2)(c), is denied as moot.
