## <u>ORDER</u>

On January 21, 2000, Kenergy Corp. ("Kenergy") tendered for filing an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct the facilities contained in its 2000-2001 Construction Work Plan. A review of the application reveals that it is deficient due to the omission of: (1) the estimated cost of operation after the proposed facilities are completed, as required by 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(f); and (2) an original, signed copy of the engineering report set forth in Exhibit C to the application, as required by KRS 322.340.

Although Kenergy has requested a general deviation from any filing requirement not satisfied, the request fails to state why the filing requirements cannot be satisfied or to otherwise show good cause to support a deviation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Kenergy's request for a general deviation from the filing requirements for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is denied.

2. Within 10 days of the date of this Order, Kenergy shall file the information required by 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(f), and KRS 322.340.
